

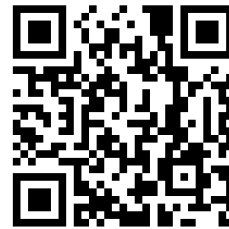
Notice to Voters

Voting Before Election Day

- You can vote early by mail, in person, or from the military or abroad.
- Vote early in-person at Itasca County Courthouse M-F 8 am to 4:30 pm
- Extended Absentee Voting Hours at the courthouse on Saturday, March 2nd 9 am to 3 pm & Monday, March 4th 8 am to 5 pm.
